CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

TREK JORDAN 31st October – 7th November 2010

1. Autism Jersey is acting as agent for “**Classic Tours**” (ATOL No.3379). You will be bound by “**Classic Tours**” Booking Conditions once you have been accepted to take part in the event. These will be sent to you when you register or you can request a copy in advance.
2. To reserve your place on Trek Jordan with Autism Jersey, and as an indication of your serious fundraising intent, we require a non-refundable registration fee payable to Autism Jersey of £300 and a commitment to raising **at least** £1,600 in sponsorship money for Autism Jersey. All of the sponsorship money raised will go to the work of the charity. **Nb: this £1,600 is in addition to and separate from all of the tour costs as per condition 3.**
3. The tour costs are expected to be in the region of approximately £1,450 (less £300 non-refundable registration fee), this figure is based on a minimum of 20 people taking part in the event. This estimate includes airport taxes and fuel surcharges which are currently approximately £205 and subject to change but does not include your travel to London Gatwick (to allow for personal choice as to when you travel to the UK these flights are to be booked by each individual);
4. 100% of the money due (sponsorship and tour costs) **MUST** be paid over to Autism Jersey ten weeks prior to the departure date i.e. 22nd August 2010. If you are unable to meet these requirements you may forfeit your place on the event – you can, of course, make up the shortfall yourself.
5. If you are unable to meet the full cost of the travel (estimated at approximately £1,450 plus Jersey/London Gatwick return flights) this must be advised to Autism Jersey at the time of registration. You may then raise a higher amount in sponsorship to cover the shortfall which will be agreed with Autism Jersey and clearly published on all your sponsorship material i.e. if you can only raise say £450 towards your tour costs, then £1,100 of the minimum £3,050 that you will have raised will be used to pay your travel costs, the balance going to Autism Jersey in sponsorship and tour costs.
6. Should you, for whatever reason, not be able to take up your place all sponsor forms and monies collected **MUST** be paid over to Autism Jersey and, if so requested, be returned to the sponsor.
7. You must be over the age of 18 by the date of departure.
8. You **MUST** be in possession of a current passport valid for at least six months from the date you return to the UK.
9. Autism Jersey and Classic Tours reserve the right to alter or revise the itinerary should circumstances dictate.
10. Autism Jersey and Classic Tours reserve the right to refuse participation without disclosing the reason.
11. You must arrange your own suitable travel insurance that will cover you for all activities you will be undertaking including medical expenses, emergency repatriation, accident and loss and provide proof prior to departure. A copy of your policy **MUST** be forwarded to Autism Jersey 10 weeks prior to departure. No one will be permitted to travel or participate without adequate insurance cover.
12. You will be required to complete a medical form once you have registered. If you are 65 or over, or have a pre-existing medical condition or you have received hospital treatment within the last 12 months, your medical form must be signed by your doctor confirming that you are fit to undertake the challenge. Autism Jersey must be informed of any changes in your medical condition that occur between submitting your medical form and the departure date.
13. All participants take part in Trek Jordan with Autism Jersey at their own risk.
14. Classic Tours will arrange flights departing from London and accommodation. It will provide a support crew, which will include doctor and guides. Autism Jersey and Classic Tours are unable to accept any responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or injury, however arising for the cancellation or curtailment of the event for any reason outside their control.
